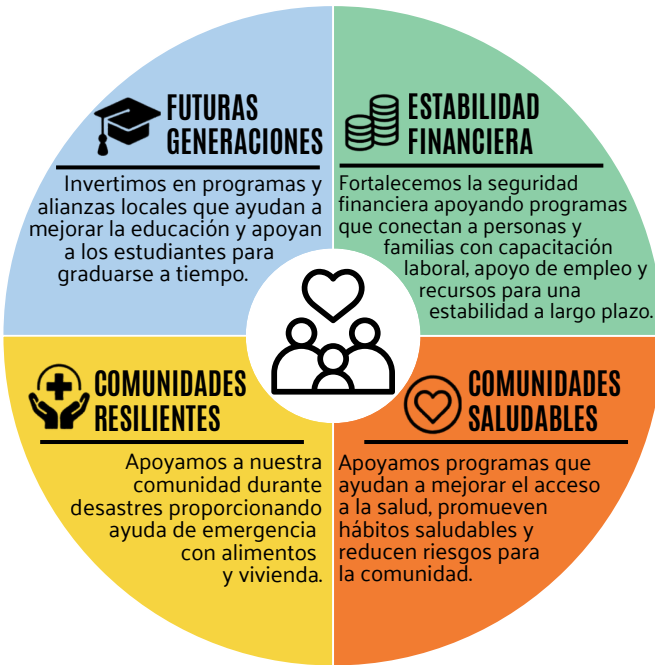


LO QUE HACEMOS
